

Register to vote online at myvote.wi.gov or register in person at Clerk's Office from 8:00AM-5:00PM Monday-Friday until March 31, 2023. You can always register on Election Day at the polls. Remember all voters must submit proof of residence with their voter registration. Go to elections.wi.gov and click on "Voters" for more information.

Request an Absentee Ballot by E-Mail, Online, or by Fax

Voters may request that a ballot be sent to them by sending an e-mail to their municipal clerk. Registered voters may also use www.myvote.wi.gov to request their absentee ballot by clicking "Vote Absentee." This request must be made no later than 5:00 p.m. on Thursday March 30, 2023 for an absentee ballot to be SENT to you. The last day for in person absentee voting at the Clerk's Office is Friday.

Stanley Municipal WaterWorks:

- ☐ The city is upgrading water meters to allow for automatic reading in all residential locations. If you get a door hanger asking to upgrade your meter, please call City Hall to set up an appointment. This is no charge to you and takes about 15-25 minutes.
- ☐ When watering your garden or washing your vehicle, please make sure to use a vacuum breaker on the outside hose bib in compliance with the City Cross Connection Ordinance. Please contact the Clerk's Office if you need one.
- ☐ If you have any type of water leak, if your toilet is running or a pipe is leaking please contact City Hall to notify us.
- When you are making water utility payments online please make sure you are selecting Water/Sewer Bill under payments.
- ☐ If you notice discolored water coming from your tap, we may be flushing hydrants starting in May. Running your water for 2-5 minutes should clear up any discoloration.

PERMIT

Building permits must be obtained before any work is started. An approved copy of this permit must be posted on the job site.

Stanley Police Department:

With spring just around the corner, we want to remind property owners that City ordinance 11-6-6 prohibits the storage of:

- Junk
- · Building Materials
- · Inoperable/Unregistered Vehicles
 - Appliances
 - Tires
 - Other General Debris

Properties within the city that are found to be in violation will receive written notice and will be given 10 days to bring their property into compliance.

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE ORDER WILL RESULT IN THE ISSUANCE OF A \$200.00 CITATION EACH AND EVERY SUBSEQUENT DAY UNTIL SAID VIOLATION(S) ARE RECTIFIED.

Thank you for keeping your lawn looking great! In Ordinance with Section 8-1-6, please keep your grass height under eight (8) inches in height. Failure to keep your grass trimmed will result in a five (5) day notice and a potential fine.

Stanley Fire Department:

Burn Permits can only be issued by the Fire Chief. Please only burn brush and natural wood. No household materials should be getting burned.

For Your Safety:

Per City ordinance 6-2-13, all homes and buildings must have the assigned street numbers immediately located above or to the side of the main door. These numbers should be a minimum of 3 inches tall and in a contrasting color for maximum visibility. This allows for Emergency Services to be able to locate the correct address in a reasonable timeframe.

Stanley Wastewater Treatment Facility:

- ❖ Never flush disposable diapers, disposable wipes, sanitary napkins or paper towels down the toilet. They could stop your drains, may damage your plumbing system, and could cause a sewer backup in the main system and lift stations.
- Avoid putting grease down your garbage disposal or household drain. It can solidify, collect debris and accumulate in City lines or build up in your own system.
- Do not flush unused medication down the toilet or drain. Please drop off any unused over the counter and prescription medications at the Stanley Police Department.
