The 2023 Real Estate and Personal Property taxes are now due

If you wish to use the installment method for paying your Real Estate taxes, you must pay the amount that is in the box entitled "1st installment payment" to the City Clerk-Treasurer by January 31, 2024. The balance would be payable to the Chippewa County Treasurer no later than July 31, 2024.

To pay your taxes in person, visit City Hall during office hours from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday or after hours in the night drop located in the drive thru. City Hall is located at 353 South Broadway St, Stanley, WI 54768. Tax payments may also be mailed to the City of Stanley at **P.O. Box 155**, Stanley, WI 54768 or paid online by clicking on the Payments & Donations icon on the City's website and selecting Pay Taxes Online: www.stanleywisconsin.us. You can also find your receipt online at the Chippewa County website (prior to 01/02/2024: www.co.chippewa.wi.us; after 01/02/2024: www.chippewacountywi.gov), click on the Property Tax tab, and search by name or parcel number.



To allow our hard-working City Crew the ability to remove snow (and per City Ordinance), there is no parking on City Streets from November 15 – April 1 during the hours of 3:00am – 6:00am. Also, please remember sidewalks need to be shoveled and cleared of ice within 24 hours after a storm.

City Streets crews will be out picking up discarded trees again this year on Thursdays after December 25.

Owners of dogs and/or cats older than five (5) months of age must be licensed each calendar year. Please bring the veterinary form with the following information when you apply for a license for your pet:

- Dog/cat name
- Date of rabies vaccination
- Clinic name
- Vaccine Certificate # (serial #)
- Rabies Tag #
- Vaccination expiration date

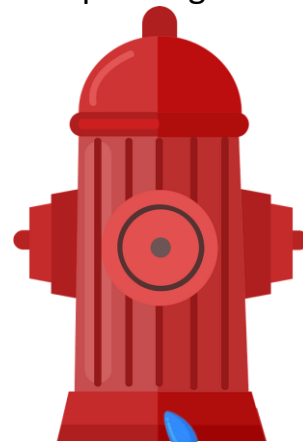
UNALTERED: \$16.00
