- 4. Completed MV2673 Maior Homemade Parts Statement Repaired Salvage Vehicle form, wisconsindot.gov/Documents/formdocs/mv2673.doc; attach bills of sale for all major components.
- 5. Documentation certifying that a 4-wheel alignment has been conducted and all wheels were properly aligned. If the vehicle frame was not damaged to such an extent to be noticeably out of wheel alignment, and did not require the vehicle to be realigned, request MV2859 Salvage Vehicle Statement from your inspector.
- Documentation certifying the entire airbag system has been checked and is in proper working condition. If the airbags 6. were not deployed as a result of the damage on the vehicle, request MV2859 Salvage Vehicle Statement from your inspector.
- 7. Pictures of the vehicle before repair - front, rear, passenger side and driver's side. The pictures will be retained by the inspector. If you do not have pictures of the vehicle prior to the repairs, request MV2859 Salvage Vehicle Statement from your inspector.
- 8. \$80.00 inspection fee, plus sales tax and any registration fees; refer to the MV1 Wisconsin Title & License Plate Application for instructions.
- 9. Make one check (or money order) payable to **Registration Fee Trust**.

It is only legal to operate your vehicle to and from the inspection location, or to and from a repair facility per Wisconsin Statutes 341.05(19). For information on parts for a vehicle/motorcycle, please refer to Wisconsin Statutes Chapter 347 and Wisconsin Administrative Code (Trans Rule) 305, listed on the reverse side of this form.

Reconstructed or modified vehicles: The vehicle inspection will cover Wisconsin statutes Chapter 347- Equipment of Vehicles and Transportation Rule 305 - Standards for Vehicle Equipment. The Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards (FMVSS), specifically 49 CFR Part 571 must be maintained for the base vehicle. Additional requirements may be required to meet current year standards.
