mportant Update Regarding Payment Policies at City Hall

Starting this quarter, City Hall will be implementing a **new payment policy** for all payment types.

Returned Payment Fee: Any payment made by check, credit card, or online ACH that is returned or not honored by the customer's financial institution will be subject to a \$30 returned payment fee. This fee applies to all service types. If a single payment covers multiple services, the fee will be applied only once and not separately for each service.

Multiple Returned Payments: If a customer has two (2) returned payments within a rolling 12-month period, they will be required to use an alternative payment method for the next three (3) years.

Accepted alternative payment methods include:

- Cash
- Certified Check
- Cashier's Check
- Money Order

Stanley Police Department Spring Reminders

Spring Cleanup Notice: With warmer weather approaching, we want to remind property owners that City Ordinance 11-6-6 prohibits storing the following on your property:

- •Junk & general debris
- Building materials
- Inoperable/unregistered vehicles
- Appliances
- Tires

Properties found in violation will receive a written notice and have 10 days to comply. Failure to comply will result in a \$200 citation for each day the violation continues.

Lawn Maintenance: As grass starts growing again, remember that city ordinance requires grass to be kept under 8 inches in height (Section 8-1-6). If your lawn exceeds this limit, you will receive a five-day notice to mow before fines apply.

Name of the Streets! Blowing grass into city streets is **not permitted**—it can clog storm drains and create safety hazards.

Stanley Municipal Wastewater

Help keep our sewer system running smoothly by following these important guidelines:

Not Flush: Disposable diapers, wipes (even if labeled "flushable"), sanitary napkins, or paper towels. These items can clog your drains, damage your plumbing, and cause sewer backups in the city's main system and lift stations.

No Grease Down the Drain:

Pouring grease down your sink or garbage disposal can lead to buildup in your plumbing and city sewer lines, causing costly blockages and repairs. Dispose of grease properly in a sealed container.

Proper Medication & Needle
Disposal: Never flush used or unused
needles or dispose of medications
down the toilet or drain. Instead,
bring unused prescription or over-thecounter medications to the Stanley
Police Department for safe disposal.

Protect Your Water Supply: When watering your garden or washing your vehicle, be sure to use a vacuum breaker on your outdoor hose bib to comply with the City Cross Connection Ordinance. If you need one, please contact the Clerk's Office.

Online Water Bill Payments: When paying your water utility bill online, please ensure you select "Water/Sewer Bill" under payments to avoid any processing issues.

Jiscolored Water? If you notice discolored water from your tap, it may be due to hydrant flushing beginning in May. Running your water for 2–5 minutes should help clear up any discoloration.

Brush Pile Reminder: The brush pile near the dam is for BRUSH ONLY! Please do not dispose of furniture, construction debris, pallets, or non-burnable materials. This service is for City of Stanley residents only—contractors and businesses are not permitted.

Compost Pile: If you're dropping off leaves or grass clippings, please avoid using plastic bags. A garbage can is available for bag disposal—your cooperation helps keep things running smoothly!

Respect Our Parks: Keep our public parks clean and enjoyable for everyone! Please clean up after your pets and treat park facilities with care.

Spring Cleanup Time! Yard work season is just around the corner! Please do not place yard waste in the roadways —let's keep our streets safe and clean together.
